Constructing the Blocks

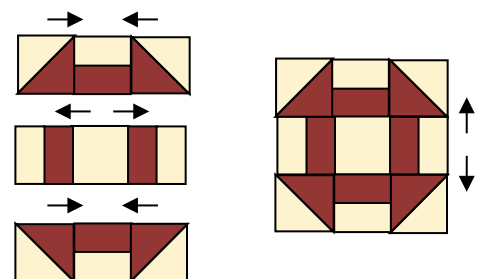
- Using a colored 1 1/2" strip and a cream 1 1/2" strip create a strip set as shown below. Press seam towards the colored strip. Make eighteen cream/colored strip sets. Sub-cut each strip set into four matching 2 1/2" segments.



- Draw a diagonal line on the back of your (36) cream 3" squares. Place colored and cream 3" squares right sides together and sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press towards the colored triangle. You should now have (72) half-square triangles. Use your Tucker Trimmer or other ruler to trim these units to 2 1/2".



- Using four matching segments, four matching half-square triangles and one cream 2 1/2" square, assemble a block as shown below. Sew into three rows first and press in the direction of the arrows. Then sew the three rows together. Make a total of 18 blocks.



Assembling the Quilt Center

4. Sew blocks into three rows of six as shown. Press as desired.

5. Sew block rows together with cream $36\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" strips.



6. Add cream inner border. Sew the $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $36\frac{1}{2}$ " strips to the left and right sides of the quilt first, then sew the $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x 29" strips to the top and bottom. Press towards the borders.

Add Applique

7. Trace all your applique shapes onto fusible web. See wool cutting directions above for wools used and number of each template needed.
8. Cut out all your shapes approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ " outside of the drawn lines and iron onto correct color wool. Now cut out all your applique pieces on the drawn lines and peel off paper backing.
9. Using the cover picture for placement, lay out all of your applique shapes on your quilt and fuse them in place. You will need to carefully curve your long stem pieces as you fuse.
10. Stitch all pieces down using a buttonhole stitch and matching threads.

Add Outer Border

11. At this point, your quilt should measure 29" x 38". Determine the actual length of your quilt by measuring in three places and taking the average of the three.
12. Trim two of your green border strips to match the length of the quilt and sew to the two sides. Press towards the border.
13. Determine the actual width of your quilt by measuring from side to side (including the side borders) in three places and taking the average of the three.
14. Trim your remaining two green border strips to match the width of the quilt and sew to the top and bottom. Press towards the border again.
15. Quilt as desired and then bind with your $2\frac{1}{2}$ " green binding strips.
