 W1105 Gold	½ yard	(7) 2 ¼" x width of fabric strips for inner border



Making the Blocks

Construct the Half-Square Triangle Units


1. Choose two matching cream and two matching colored 3" squares. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the two cream 3" squares. Place cream and a colored 3" square right sides together and sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut apart on the drawn line and press towards colored triangle. You should now have four matching half-square triangles. Trim your half-square triangles to 2 1/2".




*These units should now measure 2 1/2" (2" finished)

Constructing the Corner Combination Units

2. Sew together a half-square triangle unit and a matching cream 2 1/2" x 3 1/4" rectangle as shown. Pay close attention to the orientation of the triangle. Press towards the cream rectangle. Make four of these rectangle units.




3. Sew two rectangle units together as shown. Repeat to make two.




These units should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$

4. On the wrong side of the unit, clip the seam in the center (where marked) and press towards the cream rectangle on both sides.




Back of unit


5. Draw two diagonal lines on the back of the unit using a ruler with 45° markings. Use the picture as a guide. Each line should start in one corner and end slightly away from the opposite corner. The line should also hit the point of the half-square triangle.



6. Place a rectangle unit and a matching colored $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 5\frac{1}{4}''$ rectangle right sides together and sew on the lines you drew.



7. Cut apart in the middle and press towards the dark triangle. You should have two matching corner combination units.





These units should measure $4\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$

8. Repeat this process so that you have a total of four matching corner combination units.

Block Assembly

9. Using your four matching corner combination units, four matching cream $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 4\frac{1}{2}''$ rectangles and one matching colored $2\frac{1}{2}''$ square, assemble the block as shown below. Sew into three rows first and press in the direction of the arrows, then sew the three rows together and press as desired.




10. Repeat the above process to make a total of 30 blocks.

Assembling the Quilt Center

1. Lay out your blocks, sashing strips and cornerstones using the cover photo as a guide.
2. Sew together five cream $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$ sashing strips and six colored $2\frac{1}{4}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$ cornerstones as shown below to create a sashing row. Press towards the cream sashing strips. Make seven sashing rows.



3. Sew together five blocks and six $10\frac{1}{2}'' \times 2\frac{1}{4}''$ cream sashing strips as shown below to create a block row. Press towards the cream sashing strips again. Make six block rows.



4. Sew sashing rows and block rows together to complete the quilt center. Press towards the sashing rows.



Add Borders

5. At this point, your quilt should measure $61'' \times 72\frac{3}{4}''$. Determine the actual length of your quilt by measuring in three places and taking the average of the three.
6. Using three of your gold $2\frac{1}{4}''$ strips, construct two long strips to match the length of the quilt and sew to the two sides. Press towards the border.
7. Determine the actual width of your quilt by measuring from side to side (including the side borders) in three places and taking the average of the three.
8. Use your remaining gold $2\frac{1}{4}''$ strips to construct two border strips to match the width of the quilt and sew to the top and bottom. Press towards the border again.
9. Using the same method, measure and add your side red border and then, finally, add your red top and bottom borders.
10. Quilt as desired and then bind with your $2\frac{1}{2}''$ red binding strips.
